Doylestown is alive with the hustle and bustle that marks a place where everyone wants to be. Whether you work here or are stopping by to shop, dine, attend the County Theater, visit the museums, or just hang out, parking nearby will be on your list of things to do. This guide can help you locate the parking areas that put you close to your destination, while alerting you to the hourly limit. Since feeding the meter is strictly prohibited, **PARK SMART** by choosing a yellow banded 10-hour metered space for visits longer than three hours on Monday through Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. By selecting a parking spot appropriate for your length of stay, you will remember the visit instead of a fine.

PARK SMART, AVOID FINES

\$5.00 for an expired meter, \$35.00 for feeding meter after initial period.

FREE PARKING

At the Bucks County Parking Garage

Free parking for all, located across from the courthouse and near the town center. Enter from Main Street or Union Street.

At Free 15-minute Spaces

For short errands or grab and go convenience
Corner locations on State Street, Main Street, and in the Dommel Way Parking Lot.

METERED PARKING

At 3-hour Meters

*Up to 3 hours for .25 cent per hour.
Accepts nickels, dimes and quarters.*

Located along the streets in central downtown and in municipal lots on W. Court Street, Pine at E. State St, and E. Oakland Ave at Donaldson St.

At Designated 10-hour Yellow Banded Meters

Up to 10 hours for .25 cents for each two hours of meter time. Only accepts quarters.

PERMIT PARKING

Buy a permit to park at 10 hr meters. Purchase a six-month permit at Borough Hall for \$50. Display it on your driver's side dashboard. Can be transferred to another vehicle and no coins are needed when you park.

PAY & DISPLAY LOT

Hamilton & W. State Street Municipal Lot-one block from W. State and Main Street, in the heart of downtown. Metered by machine- pay and then display the ticket on your dash. .25 cent/hr, credit cards, dollars, coins (no change made).

TRAIN & BUS

Pay and Park at Septa Lot. For overnight, use free spaces on S. Clinton St or Bridge St.

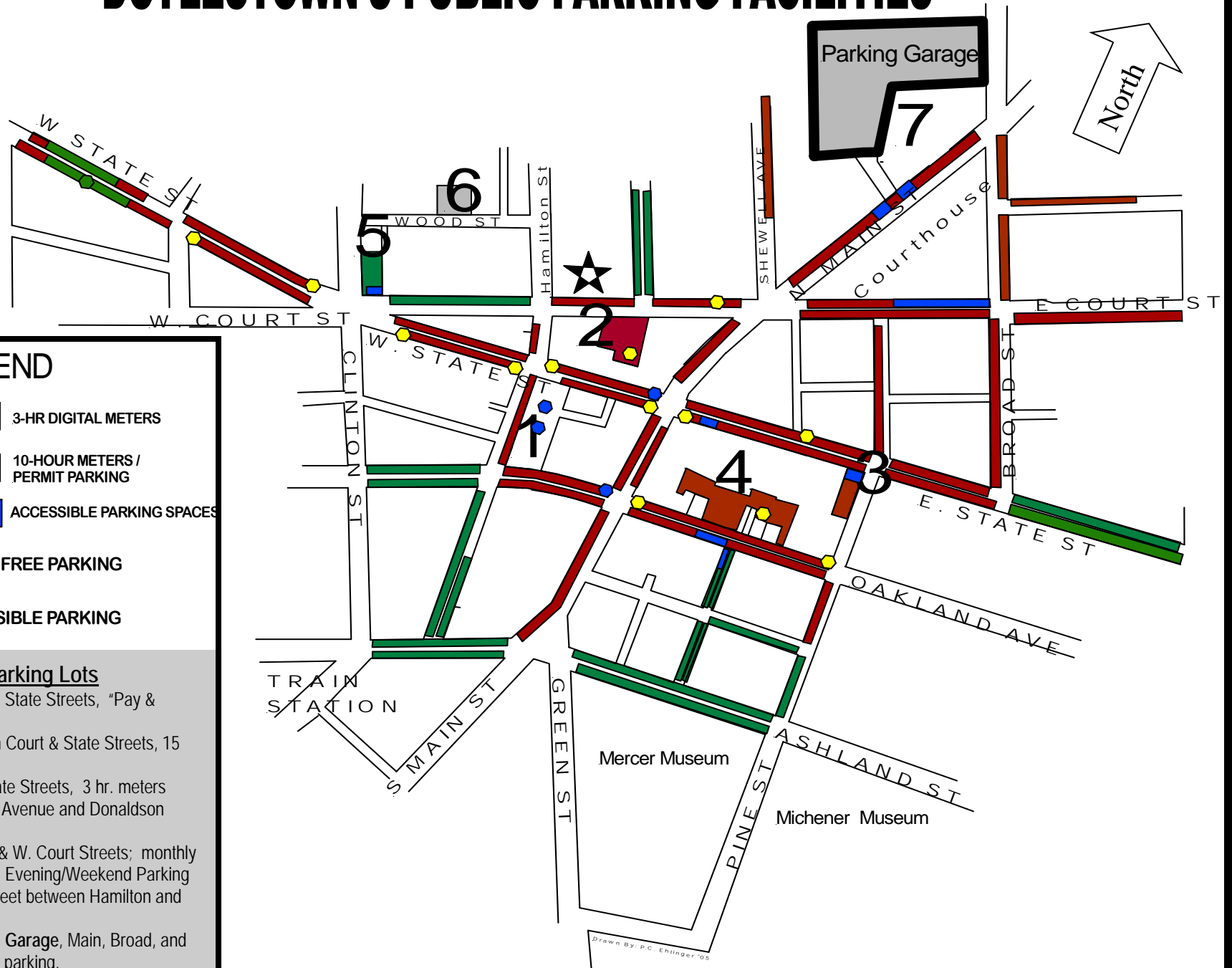

Public Parking Lots

1. Plaza West, Hamilton & State Streets, "Pay & Display" system
2. Dommel Way, Between Court & State Streets, 15 min. & 3 hr. parking
3. Pine Street, Pine & State Streets, 3 hr. meters
4. Plaza East, E. Oakland Avenue and Donaldson Street, 3 hr. meters.
5. Clinton Street, Clinton & W. Court Streets; monthly rentals, 10 hr. meters, Free Evening/Weekend Parking
6. Wood Street, Wood Street between Hamilton and Clinton; monthly rentals.
7. Bucks County Parking Garage, Main, Broad, and Union Streets, 24 hour free parking.
